Latest Messages from CCN on Mana Ake

1. OUTCOMES AND EVALUATION FRAMEWORK

An evaluation framework was tabled for the Mana Ake initiative. It has four outcomes – healthy whānau/families; children have strong social learning environments; children have strong education connections; and a connected education, health and social system – and outlines what is monitored under each outcome, and how.

The data captured by the framework will be extracted to create a dashboard-style report for the SLA, which will be used to report across the health system and government-level feedback.

2. LEADING LIGHTS

Leading Lights is designed for educators and supports them to recognise and respond and/or request support when a wellbeing concern is identified. A number of pathways are being created, including for developmental and learning concerns and social/emotional and/or behavioural concerns.

Information on the site is being constantly revised and updated in response to feedback received through the 'send feedback' button.

3. NEW APPROACH TO DESIGNING MANA AKE

The Mana Ake project design has been realigned in response to the shift from the initial development phase to ongoing implementation and service improvement. This new phase will see a Practice Lead role complement the existing project structure and realign the current work groups to focus on enhancing practice and implementation support for schools, kaimahi and providers.
